1. Are they licensed

You can verify license status and see if there are any complaints or judgments against their license as well. If they don't have a license number or its a license number tied to a different name or company thats a huge red flag; run away!!

2. Are they insured

Don't just take their word for it. Ask for a COI (certificate of insurance, it'll make you sound well researched) with current status and coverage. A reputable insured company will be able to have one emailed to you within one business day.

3. Do they have references
